**COMPETITION GUIDELINES**

1. Artworks accepted: Painted art, sculpture, collage, photography, embroidery, textile, costume, fantasy hair and make-up.
2. Artwork photographs must be submitted on disc. DO NOT send your original artwork at this stage
3. Closing date for this competition is 30<sup>th</sup> September 2009-05-07
4. Entry fee for the competition is £5.00. This fee is strictly for admin purposes only. This covers postage to and from the judges, meeting point hire for the judges, web

admin. This fee entitles the artist to free admission to the 29<sup>th</sup> November Arts & Crafts Event.

5. All entries MUST be strictly original artworks. It is wonderful to be inspired by other artists, but we want to see YOUR art, learn about YOUR technique, and judge and maybe exhibit YOUR artwork and its unique inspiration.
6. There will be 10 finalists chosen from each category, from which our judges will choose the two final winning pieces of art.
7. Ideally we would like all 20 finalists to attend the 29<sup>th</sup> Nov Arts and Crafts Event  
On this day the two winners will be announced by our judges and the prizes awarded. This Event will be a great opportunity to see the work of your peers, meet other young artists, meet many of the world's most prolific and famous professional illustrators, fine artists, artisan craftspeople, performers, etc. working at the highest levels in this genre of the arts.
8. A purpose built website will be constructed to display ALL entrants submitted artwork. This will be online in 2010. It will create an opportunity for young artists to have their art displayed as part of a professional online gallery, with the opportunity to sell and market their artwork.
9. The artwork of all 20 finalists (10 from each category) will be exhibited at The Flavel during the two day event.
10. This IS about competition, but it is also about forging friendships that have one unique element- a mutual love of the Arts, and especially this genre.
